Riverside Park:

STMP:

Manager Welch reported that Council was asked to review the Strategic Management Planning Program Report and to pick three to five items they would like to achieve from Phase II of the grant. Jonas is here to advise us on what it might cost. He recommended starting off with small things such as "IT" Information Technology, establish and increase fees and fines appropriately, jobs descriptions, etc....After much conversation, Council will look into IT, Accounts Funding Software, parking and facility studies, codification of the ordinances and succession planning for the manager. Each phase will match up to \$200,000.00
